



Adopt A Fellowship

Where do you go to find an ethnic leader or resources to meet the needs of your increasingly ethnic church and community?

Growth in the Assemblies of God has primarily been fueled by a growing number of ethnic minorities and immigrants finding a spiritual home in an AG church. Over 40% of current adherents in the USA are presently ethnic minorities. Since 1993, there has been a 41% increase in minority AG churches. The number will continue to grow.

The number of Ethnic/Language fellowships has also grown; from 4 in 1996 to 21 today. Despite the growth, these emerging groups typically struggle to gain traction. They have the desire but not always the means to reach the minorities experiencing exponential growth.

That is changing in part because of a new concept called Adopt-a-Fellowship. District councils, churches, and individuals can partner financially with an Ethnic/Language fellowship. Twenty district councils along with several churches and individuals are sponsoring one or more ethnic groups with monthly financial support.

In return, these Fellowships bring to the table a wealth of skills and information to help us reach this rapidly growing ethnic harvest. Our Fellowships can help the AG plant churches, train workers, and reach souls.
