

E-LIFE: Kid-to-Kid Evangelism and Mentorship



BGMC equips kids to *pray*, to give, and to go. E-LIFE is the "GO" component that prepares kids to be missionaries to their schools and communities. It's all about kid-to-kid evangelism and mentorship!

BGMC is teaching E-LIFE Kids five basic commitments, called the E-LIFE Commitments:

- 🔗 **Seek** the Holy Spirit's help in helping others.
- 🔗 **Show** kindness and friendship—so others can see Jesus in you.
- 🔗 **Share** the story of Jesus and your story of how you came to Jesus.
- 🔗 **Invite** other kids to know Jesus and to church.
- 🔗 **Invest** in the lives of others—discipleship.

Through these "Five Commitments of an E-LIFE Kid," BGMC provides five levels of kid-friendly resources for leaders to teach:

- 🔗 Games (called **E-xtreme Fun**)
- 🔗 Object lessons (called **High Octane**)
- 🔗 Scripture pictures (called **SnapShots**)
- 🔗 Illustrated stories (called **Instant Replays**)
- 🔗 Group discussion starters and role plays (called **Get Real**)



Each lesson focuses on one of the "Five Commitments of an E-LIFE Kid." Each lesson includes activities kids can take home and to school that will enable them to mentor other kids.

The **Go 3-D Discoveries** are another key component of E-LIFE's "Invest" commitment. The Go 3-D lessons enable kids to mentor other kids.
