213 Countries and Territories

- 98 are considered un/least-reached countries or territories.

AG Ministers: 357,727

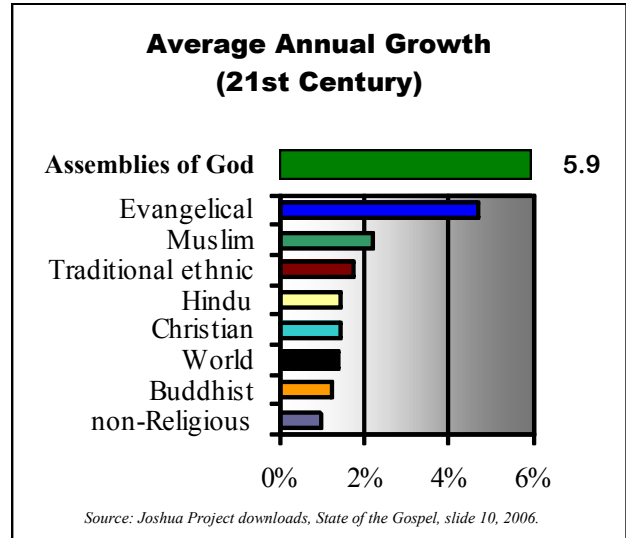
