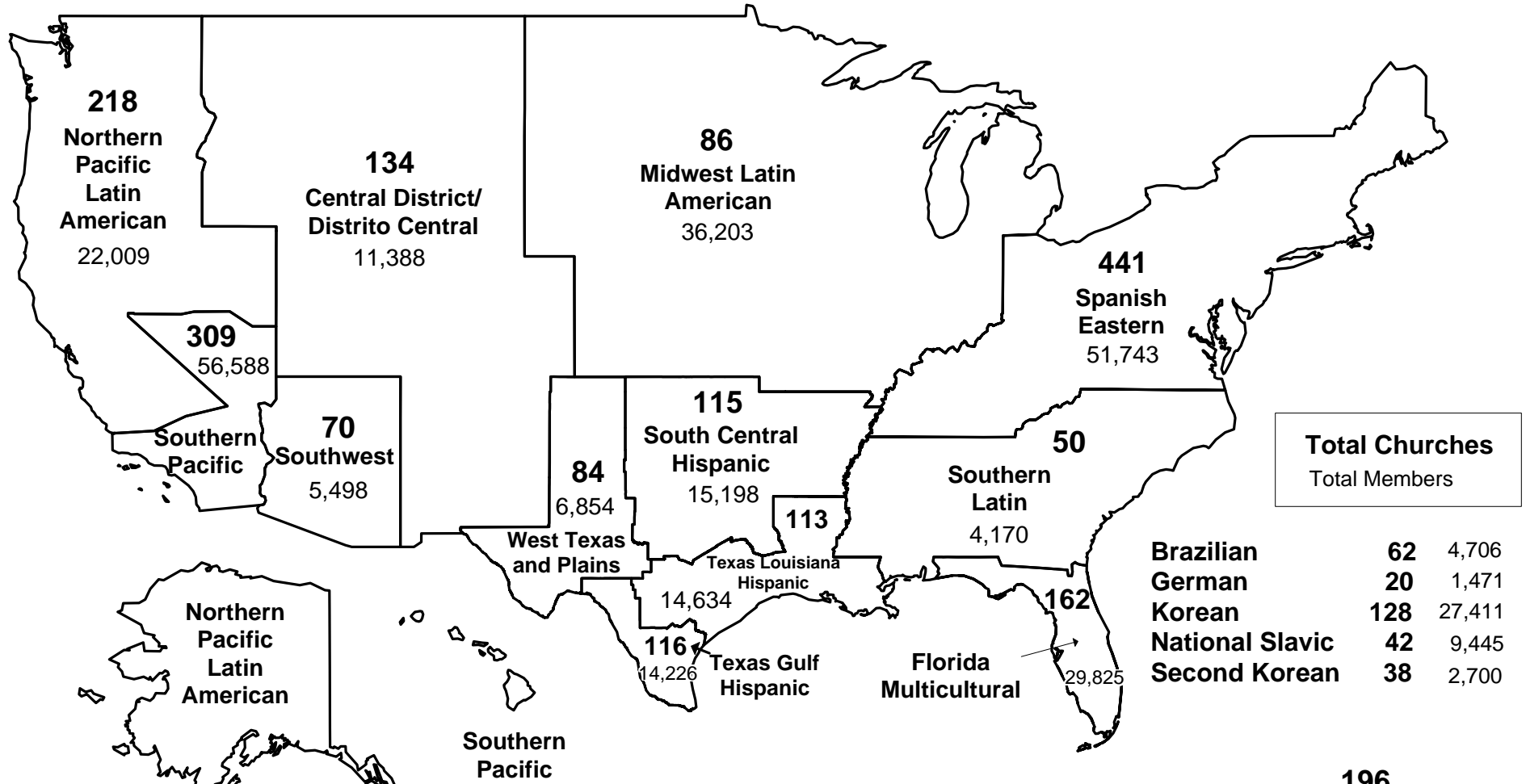

Assemblies of God *Language Districts*



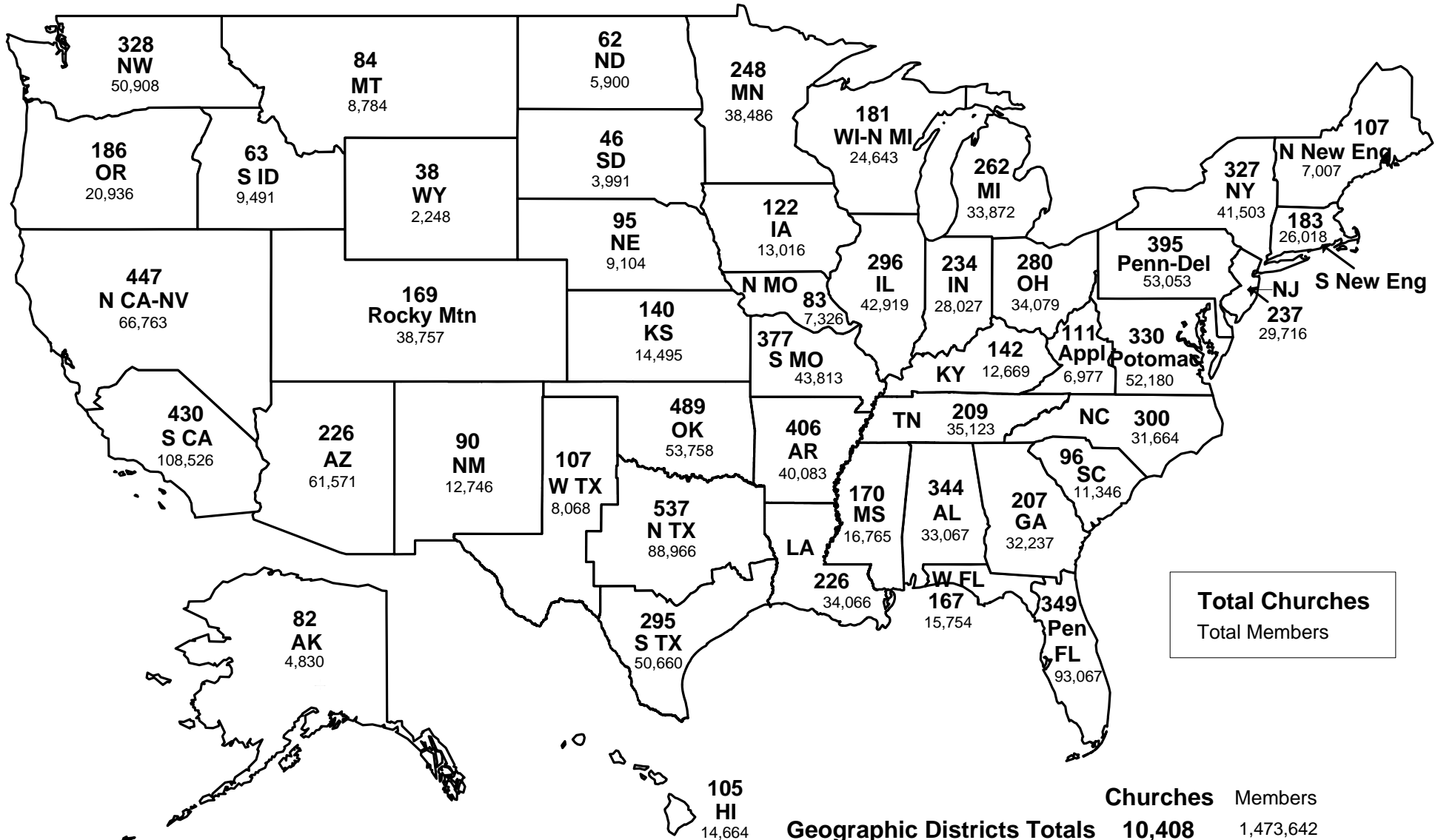

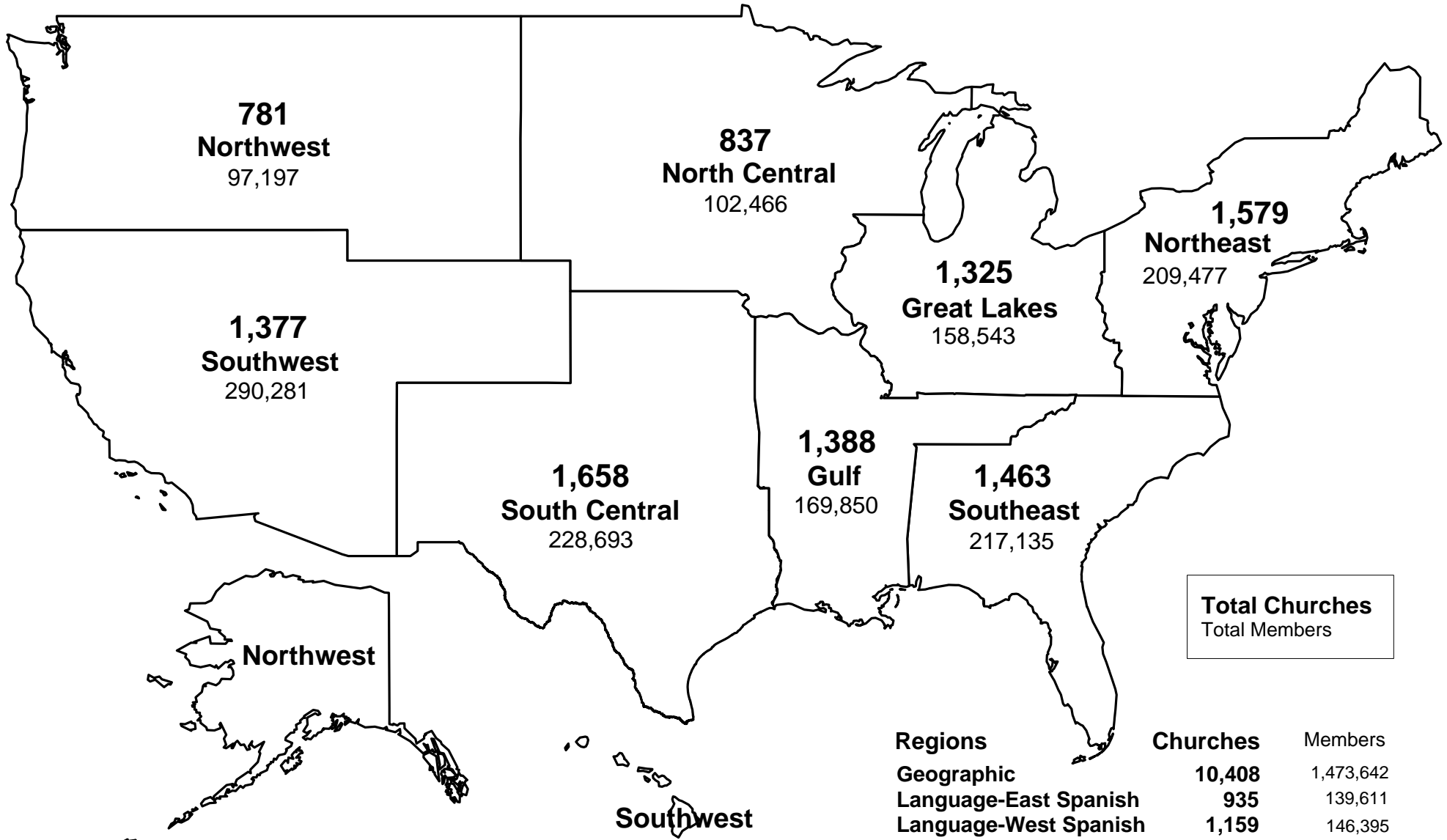
