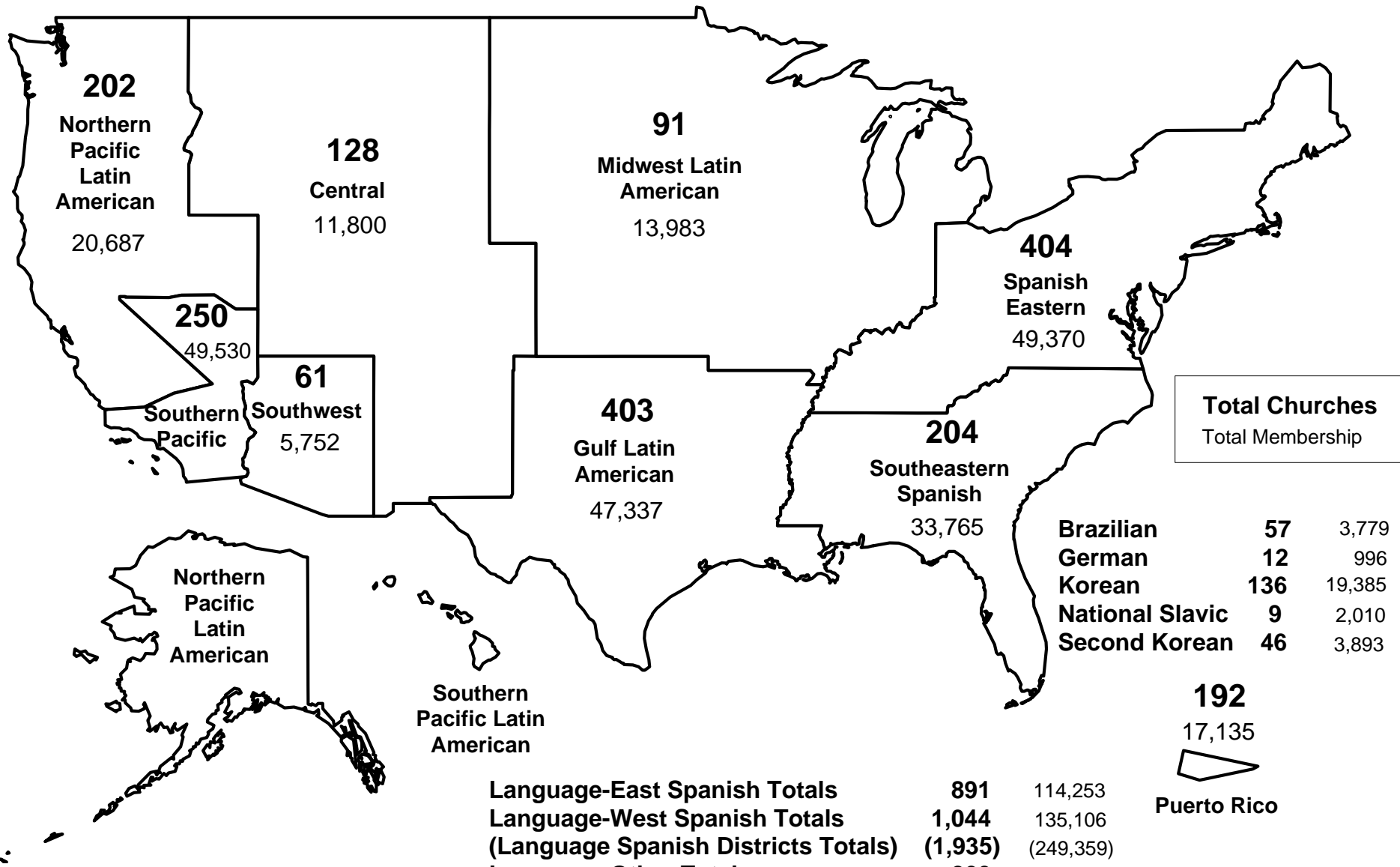

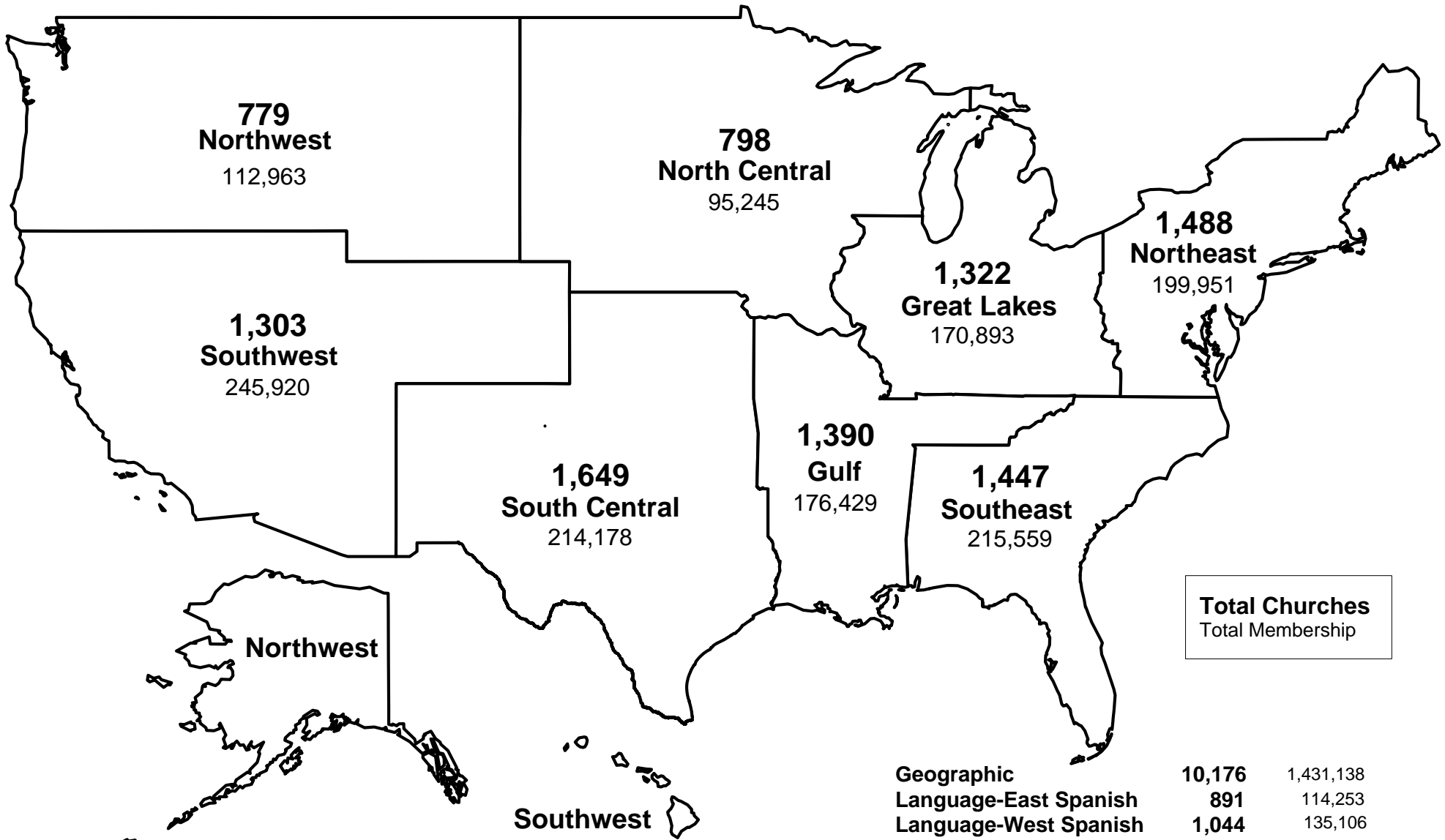

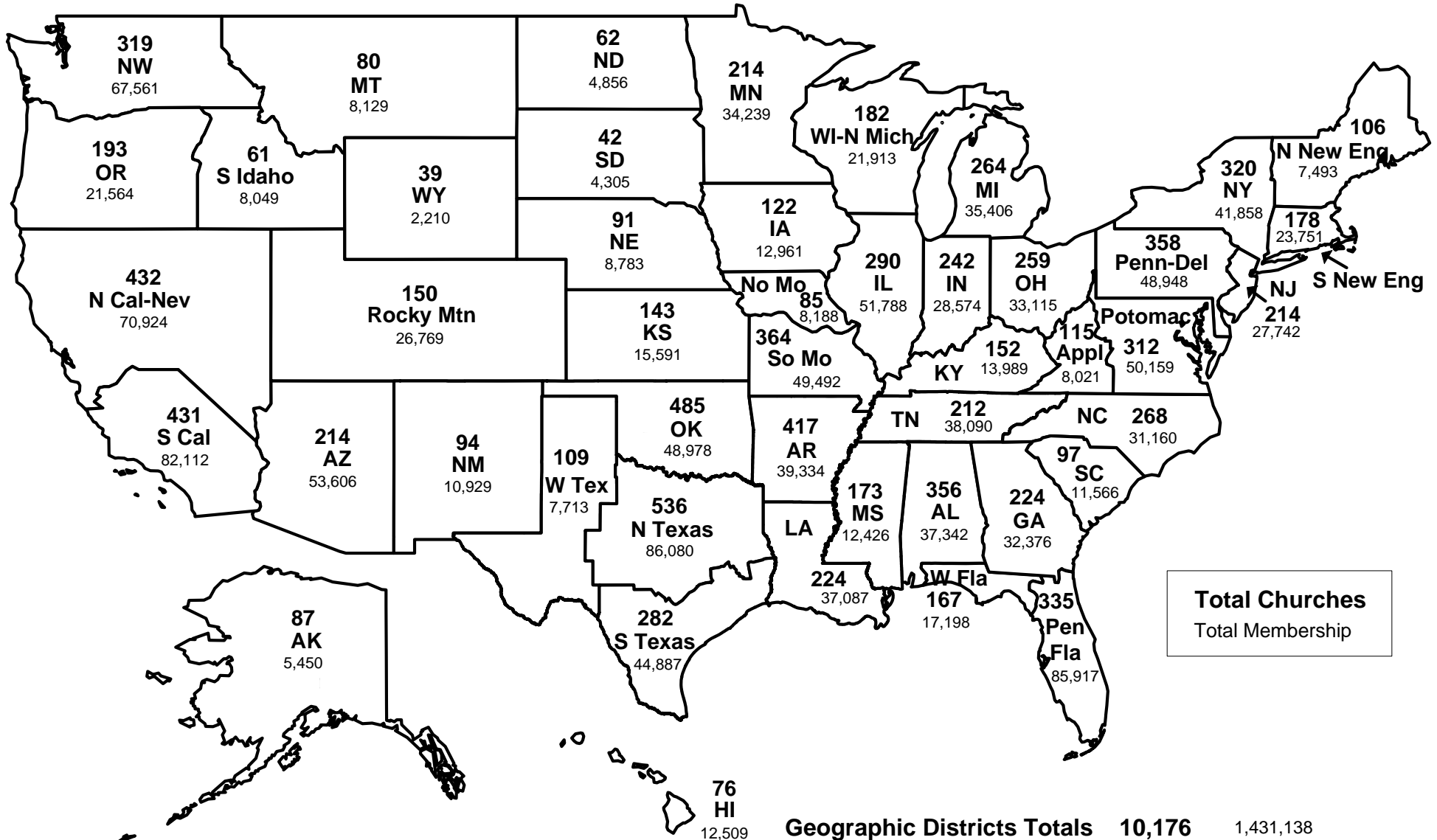
2009 Churches and Membership Assemblies of God Geographic Regions
