Message

1. He was wonderful at His birth (Luke 2:7).

Humble in birth for a king (Matthew 2:5,6; John 1:46; 1 Corinthians 1:27,28; Matthew 11:25).

2. He was wonderful in His life (Acts 10:38).

Not in wealth but in teaching and helping people (Luke 2:49; 19:10; Mark 10:45).

3. He was wonderful in His teaching (Matthew 7:28,29).

His words fell like seed, and brought forth fruit (John 6:63; 7:46; Luke 4:22).

4. He was wonderful in His mighty works (John 3:2).

His miracles left no doubt in any honest mind (John 5:36; 10:20,21; Acts 2:22).

5. He was wonderful in His death and resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:1–4).

It was a victorious death and a glorious resurrection (Revelation 1:18; Luke 23:46,47; Romans 1:4).

6. He will be wonderful in His second coming (Revelation 1:7).

A great event awaits both the world and the church (1 Thessalonians 4:16,17; Matthew 24:37–46).

7. He will be wonderful in His coming reign (Luke 1:32,33).

His coming and kingdom are associated (2 Timothy 4:1; Daniel 7:13,14,27; Psalm 72).
