Dear Friends,

John 4 tells the heartwarming story of an encounter Jesus orchestrated with a Samaritan woman trapped in emptiness. She was striving to quench her inner thirst with male relationships. When Jesus introduced her to the Living Water, this lady's burning thirst was completely satisfied beyond her expectations.

Every 4th of July, U.S. citizens celebrate freedoms that very few in the world can claim. Yet these freedoms cannot satisfy the inner need for a relationship with the Lord. This is prevalent among those who are blind. Blindness is often mistaken as the source of emptiness. Pursued solutions might be good in themselves, i.e. prayer for healing, a medical cure, education in blindness skills, but nothing can fulfill the inner thirst for Living Water.

Paul's mother, Margaret Weingartner, witnessed this while attending a Bible study in her senior apartment complex in New Jersey. A blind man attended the study with some hard questions concerning the love of the Lord in the face of tragedies and human suffering. The teacher didn't seem to have any answers for him. Paul's mother called the Center for the Blind looking for helpful resources in the DAISY format for the digital cartridge players.




