Dear Friends:


Greetings from the Center for the Blind of the Assemblies of God!

This same presentation is now in the hands of the Spanish translators. The goal is to release it in Spanish and English simultaneously.

Eighteen golf carts fitted with glow bands and ready to hit the unlit greens!






