

## Becoming an Honor Coordinator or Honor Sponsor

Honor Coordinators should be at least 18 years old and actively involved in Girls Clubs.

### Honor Coordinator Requirements

- Complete the *Girls Cubs Leader Training Guide*.
- Read all six club-level *Sponsor Guides*
- Read the *Coordinator's Guide*
- Memorize the Fivefold Purpose.
- Complete an application and send it to your district Girls Ministries director.

Leaders who choose to may become Honor Sponsors for the club they lead or for any other M'pact /Teen Girl Ministries club. Sponsors should be at least 16 years old and actively involved in the Girls Clubs.

### Honor Sponsor Requirements

- Complete the *Girls Cubs Leader Training Guide*.
- Read the entire club-level Sponsor Guide.
- Memorize all memory verses and club distinctives.
- Memorize the Fivefold Purpose.
- Complete the Honor Sponsor *fill-in-the-blank* Review and mail only the application to your district director.

### Review Procedure

- The church Girls Clubs coordinator should contact the district director to obtain a copy of the nationally standardized Honor Sponsor Review and grading key.
- Honor Sponsor candidates should be tested under the direction of a review board consisting of three mature Christian women not related to the sponsor.
- The review board is responsible to hear each candidate recite the fivefold purpose and to see that the written review is properly completed, graded, and returned to the local coordinator.
- The review board will grade the review using the key provided. A sponsor must receive a grade of at least 70 percent on each individual verse. If the review must be taken over again, she will only be responsible for the verses on which she scored lower than 70 percent and not the complete review.
- Once a passing grade is obtained, the application (cover page) should be signed and verified by your pastor. A copy should then be sent to the district director for processing.

**Note:** Honor Sponsors may continue their training by completing the *Momentum Leadership Development Units: Education, Community, and Personal Growth* in order to earn the Bronze, Silver, and Gold pins.
