






National Girls Ministries Policy for Completing Previous Clubs

Girls who wish to complete the requirements for previous clubs may do so by adhering to the following guidelines:

- Complete the requirements only for the purpose of earning the Medals of Honor
- Girls should not participate in graduation ceremonies for the clubs they are making-up. For example:
 - A high school-age girl making-up the Honor Star requirements should not be crowned an Honor Star in the graduation ceremony. However, she may be honored for earning the corresponding Medal of Honor.
- Completion of previous clubs' requirements should be done in a supervised setting with a trained sponsor, not as correspondence or an independent project at home.
- Girls who wish to earn the Medals of Honor may complete all the requirements for up to two previous clubs as follows:
 -  A girl in Stars Club may complete all the honor requirements for Prims and Daisies Clubs
 -  A girl in Friends Club may complete all the honor requirements for the Stars and Prims Clubs
 -  A girl in Girls Only Club may complete all the honor level requirements for Friends and Stars Clubs

Completing previous club requirements to earn the Medals of Honor will require coordination and considerable effort on the part of both the girl and the leader. Therefore, the process should not be initiated without considering all the factors involved.
